Language Area

We will be making crafts and projects that use this month's sounds. The Chinese sounds will be ㄨ, ㄣ, ㄝ, and ㄚ (wu, yue, yeh, and ah). We will be reading the Chinese poem 五指謠 (Wu Dz Yao).
