Language Area

We will be making crafts and projects that uses this month's sounds. The Chinese sounds will be ㄍㄜㄎㄜ and ㄘ (Ge, Ke, He, Ji and Chi). We will continue on reading the Chinese poem 三字經 (San zi Jin). We are also working on 山中吟 (San Jong Yin). In the English classroom, the sounds for this month are Li, Tt, Ss, and Pp. Children may bring objects that start with these sounds to share with the class. We will also read Stone Soup and as a community make stone soup.

Art and Music
